STUDENT ROAD SAFETY

Please read this letter from Qld Police:



Dear Parents,

With the second term of the school year well under way, it serves as a timely reminder that keeping children safe travelling to and from schools, on bicycles, walking and in vehicles is everyone's responsibility.

A number of school children are injured every year as they travel to and from school and Police are committed to providing the safest journey. Children are not always road safety conscious and can act unpredictably. Drivers/parents need to keep this in mind when travelling, or, stopping in school zones.

Police have become aware that parents are choosing to ignore speed signs, no parking zones-designated by either road markings or signs, disabled designated spaces, parking within close proximity of, and, ignoring Crossing Supervisors hand held 'Stop' signs at the children's crossings. Aside from the penalties these offences hold, they present an unacceptable danger to children, parents and Crossing Supervisors.

Traffic Infringement Notices for offences vary from \$48 - \$365 and can incur demerit points. Other enforcement action for Driving without Due Care and Attention, or Dangerous Operation of a motor vehicle can result in court appearances resulting in licence suspensions/disqualifications.

Remember, the safety of our children is everyone's responsibility to reduce injuries and ensure the safest journey for our children/students.

Nominations

- **800m** Unlimited nominations. A straight final.

- **Circular relays** Teams are selected from the times run in the heats of the 100m.

All children not nominated in a finals event will compete in the standard events on the athletics day.

Students participating in a finals event will be awarded place ribbons and eligible for age championship points.

NOTE: High Jump finals will be run on Monday 05 June and not on the day of the Athletics carnival. There will not be any high jump on the day of the carnival.
