STEMFest Challenge

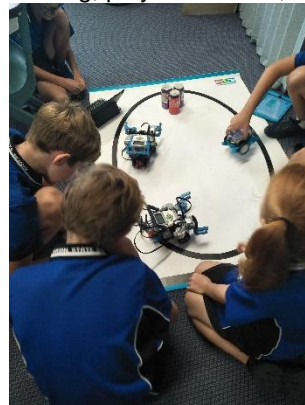
The STEMFest Challenge is being held at Yarrilee State School this term. The competition involves four categories:

Sumo: Students need to program a robot to remain in a ring while pushing all opponents and objects out of the ring.

Drawing: Students need to program a robot using code to recreate an image.

Animation: Students need to code a narrative story.

Gaming: Students need to build upon a partially designed game and use code to add gaming components, such as scoring, player interface, levels.



Twenty-five Year 5 and 6 students have entered the competition and are practising their coding skills at lunch times. The students are enjoying the challenge that coding provides and are rising to the occasion. **The competition is on Thursday 13th June,** where thirteen KSS teams will compete against other schools.

If students are interested in robotics, the STEAM Room is open in the Library every first break and offers a range of activities that centre around coding and robotics.
