## This funding will be used to

- Achieve U2B performance in Yr3 writing of 50%
- Increase the U2B performance in Yr5 writing to 30%
- Achieve U2B performance in Yr3 reading of 65%
- Increase the U2B performance in Yr5 reading to 45%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A-C achievement in English to 85%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A-C in Mathematics to 85%
- Improve 80% of targeted students A-E results in Mathematics
- Improve 80% of targeted students A-E results in English
- Ensure that 100% of teachers are provided with individualised support in English and Mathematics to develop capability around planning and the use of data.

## Our initiatives include

- Establishment of a Literacy Engagement Teacher (LET) and Numeracy Engagement Teacher (NET) to support the development of teacher capability in planning engaging units of work, aligned to the national curriculum.
- Provide teacher release time for teachers to connect with LET, NET, HOC and admin staff to develop capability around planning and the use of data through the establishment of a specialist Technology teacher and Arts teacher
- Employ an intensive teacher to maximise the number of students in U2B in reading and writing
- Employ additional teacher aides to support guided reading in P-2
- Support a weekly playgroup (Koala Joeys) for 0-4 year olds
