Road Closure – Boundary Road Extension

Critical work on the Boundary Rd extension will lead to a road closure to a small section of Grevillia St (between Snapper St and Bauhinia Drive). This will have a flow on effect to our school traffic. This work is expected to commence next week.

Council have provided to us a *Traffic Guidance Scheme* that depicts the road closure points and alternative routes to consider during this time. It is suggested that parents look at the attached maps and start thinking ahead regarding alternative routes to take to and from school. This is attached as a PDF at the back of this newsletter.

- 2) To cancel a lunch order, follow these steps via Qkr! App.
 - > Go into your 'My Receipts' in the top left menu
 - > Click on the order you wish to cancel
 - > Select the red 'cancel' circle/icon
 - > Check which item or order you'd like to cancel
 - > Confirm by clicking 'OK' Qkr! will then add credit to your Qkr! account. This amount of credit will be deducted from your next lunch order.

The cut-off time for orders is 8.50 am, so cancellations must be made before then. The tuckshop cannot initiate refunds or cancel orders via Qkr!, it must be completed by the account holder. Please email any questions or concerns to pandc@kawunganss.eq.edu.au attention the tuckshop.

- #5 Bake a cake – from scratch! (Yes, this too is creative.)

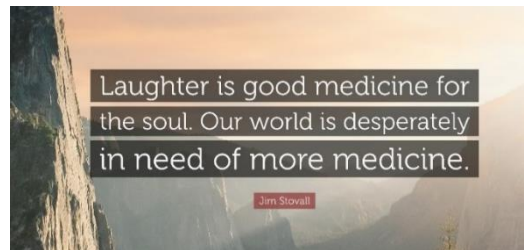


Above all, have fun and enjoy discovering more ways to be creative.

these amazing people serving in their school to make the art of music so enjoyable for all. This is all part of supporting a child's inner creativity.

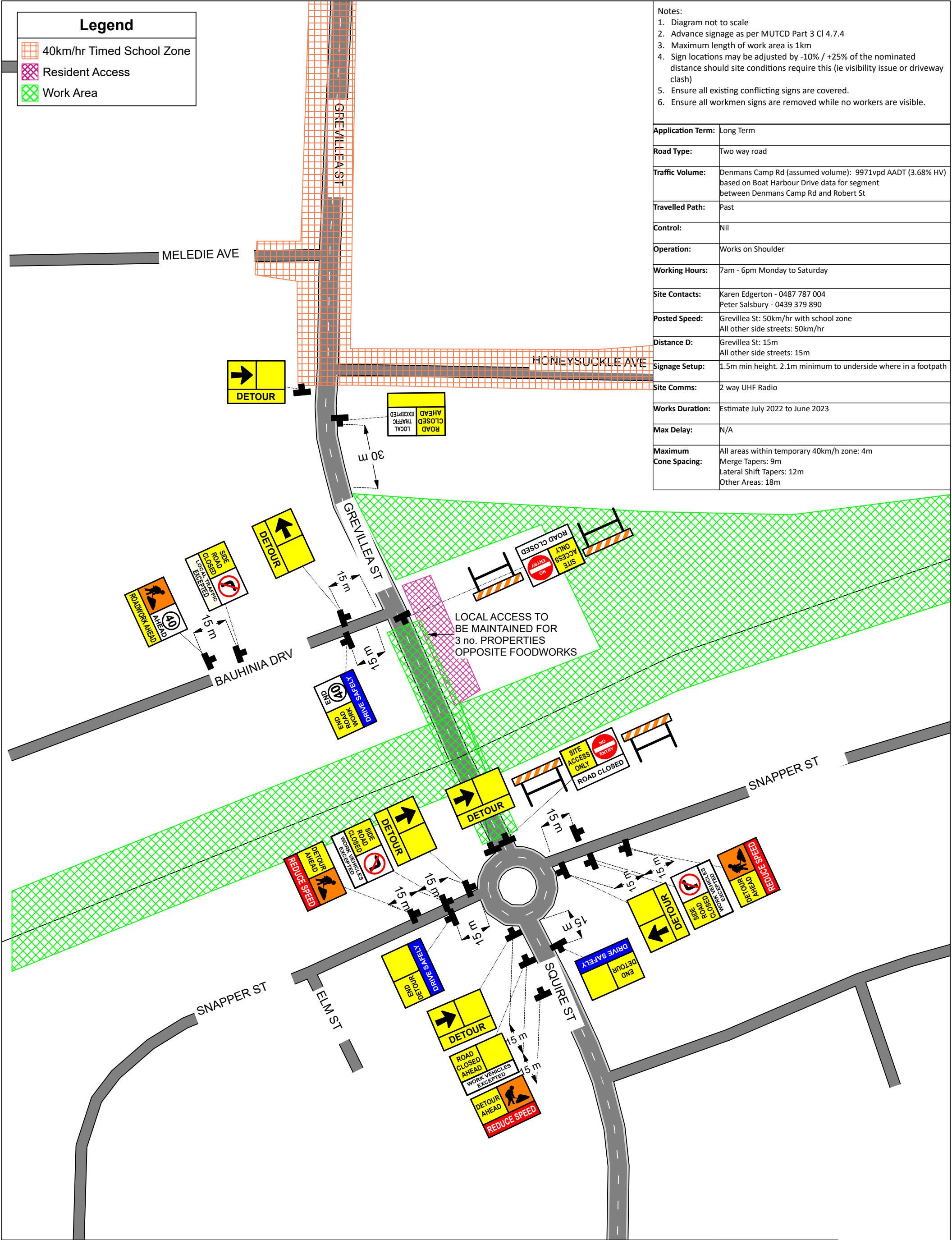


Continuing on our creative journey – see last newsletter - and how to implement creativity in the home, here are a few simple ideas:

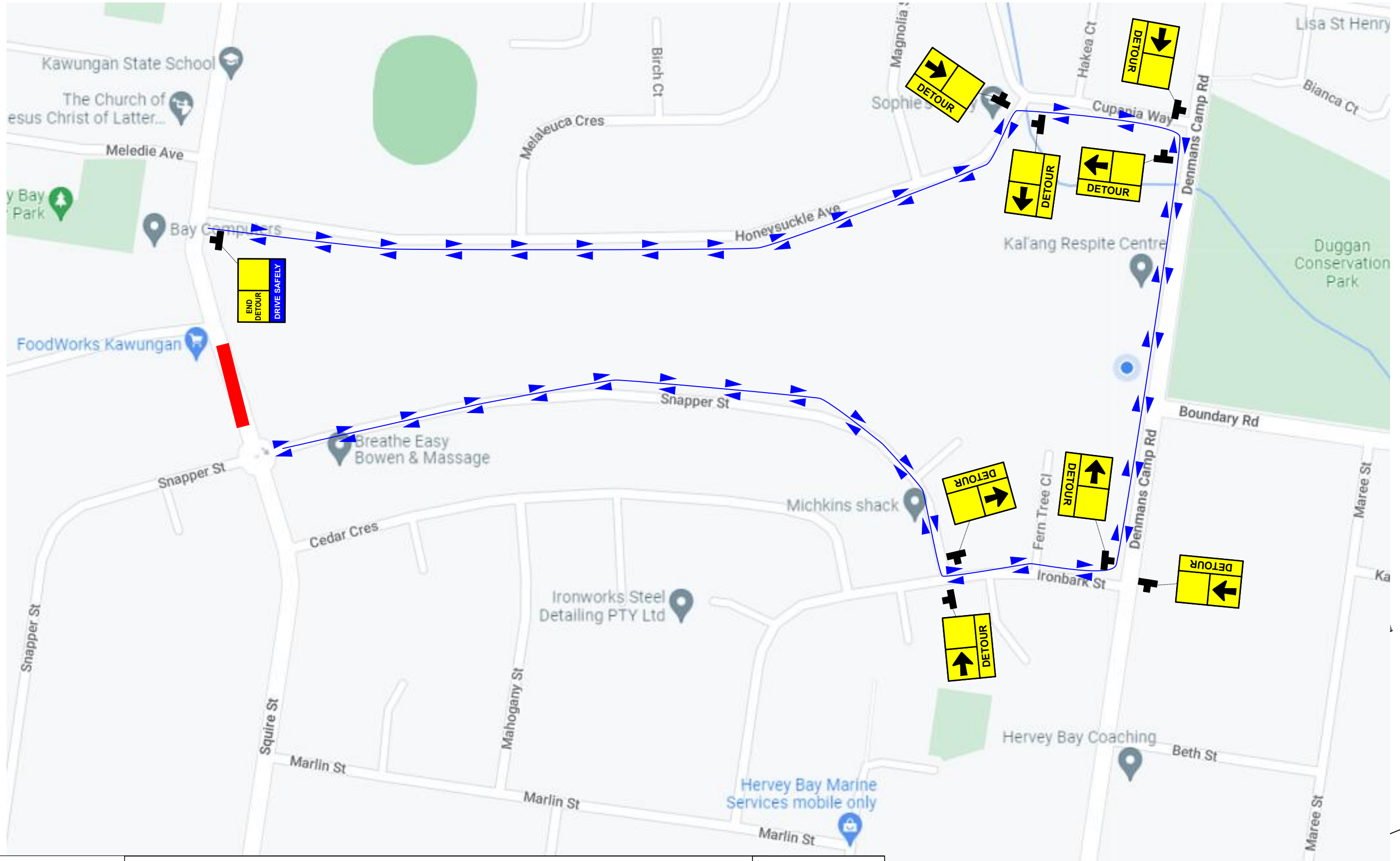
