- 2) To cancel a lunch order, follow these steps via Qkr! App.

> Go into your 'My Receipts' in the top left menu

- > Click on the order you wish to cancel
- > Select the red 'cancel' circle/icon

> Check which item or order you'd like to cancel

> Confirm by clicking 'OK' Qkr! will then add credit to your Qkr! account. This amount of credit will be deducted from your next lunch order.
