GOODBYE 2025!

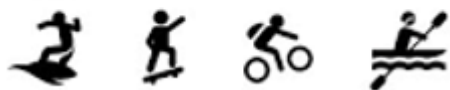

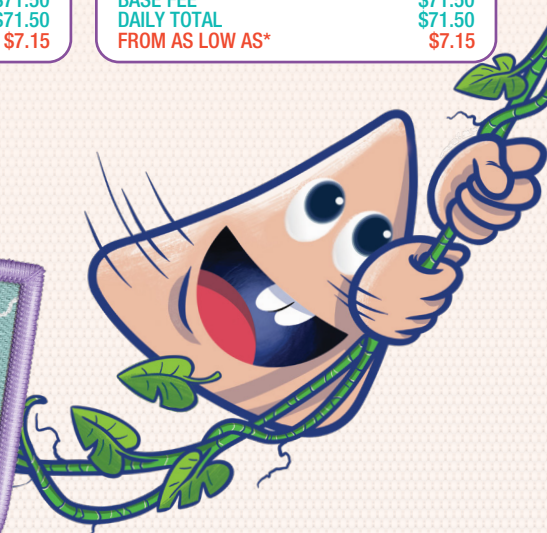
