#### This funding will be used to

- Support transitions by fostering relationships with the Kawungan community and creating
  opportunities for children and their parents to become part of the school community prior to
  starting school through our Koala Joeys Playgroup.
- Ensure that 100% of teachers engage in case management processes.
- Ensure that 100% of teachers participate in the 3 levels of planning.
- Increase the percentage of children in P-2 achieving a C or better in English to 88% by the end of Semester 2.
- Increase the percentage of children in P-6 achieving a C or better in English to 90% by the end of Semester 2.
- Increase the percentage of children in P-2 achieving a B or better in English to 60% by the end of Semester 2.
- Increase the percentage of children in P-6 achieving a B or better in English to 55% by the end of Semester 2.
- Ensure that 100% of teachers are provided with individualised support in English and Numeracy.
- Ensure that 100% of Prep students are screened in language and speech and appropriate support is provided for identified students.

#### Our initiatives include

- Supporting the funding for 2 HODC positions. This will enhance;
  - Support for teachers to align practice to the Australian Curriculum and continue to develop their capacity to plan and innovate in all KLAs.
  - Support case management processes.
  - Moderation processes (M1-M4).
- Maintain specialist teachers in the Arts and Technology KLAs to provide rich and meaningful learning experiences in these KLAs.
- Employ additional teacher aides to support students in prep-2 in reading and writing.
- Support a weekly playgroup (Koala Joeys) for 0-4 year olds.
- Provide regular release time for teachers to conduct professional development and planning.
   during additional specialist teacher lessons.
- Provide additional speech language intervention for our students in Prep 2.
- Align teacher aide support to STLANs to support our writing focus.
- Employ additional teacher to support reading in Year 3/4/5/6.
